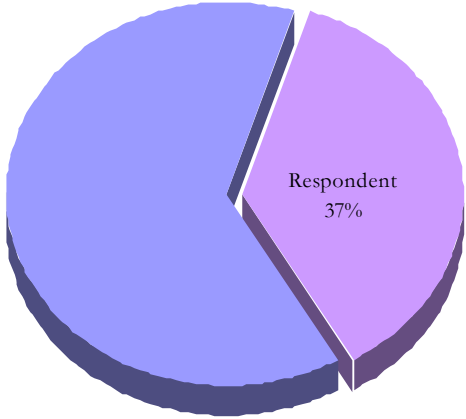

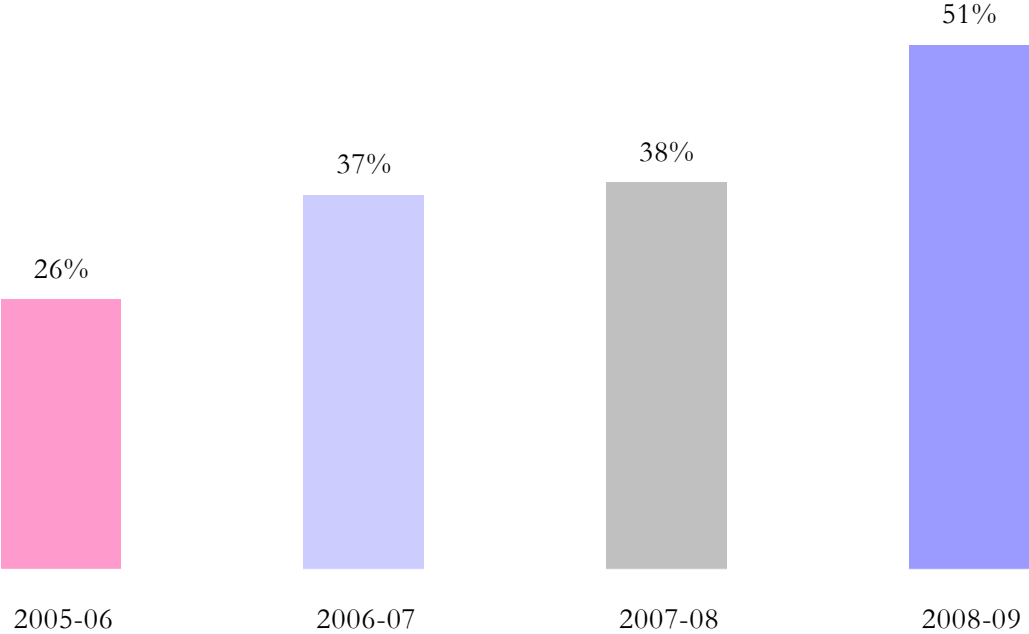
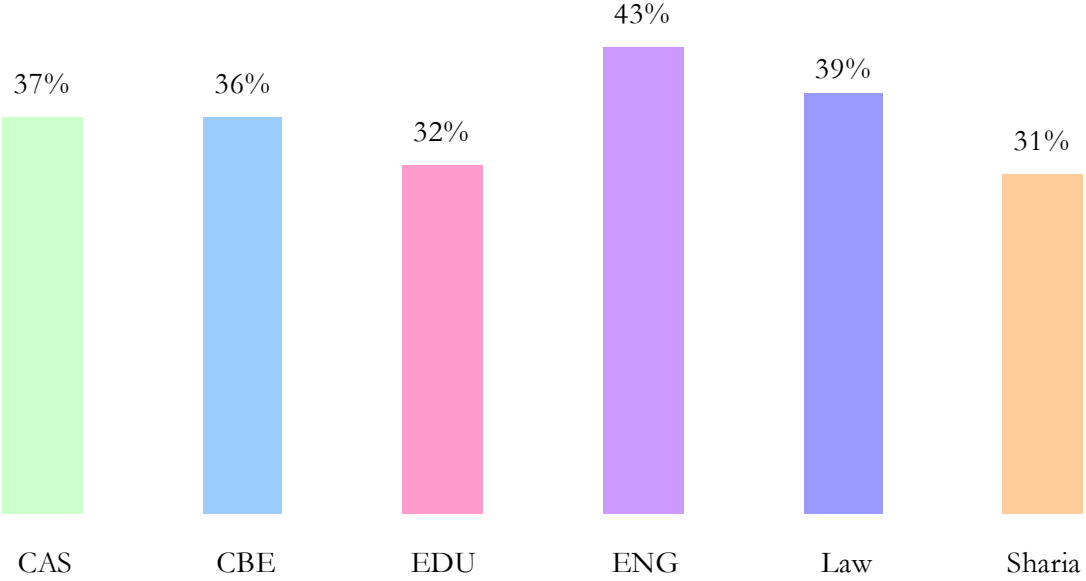
Overall Response Rate

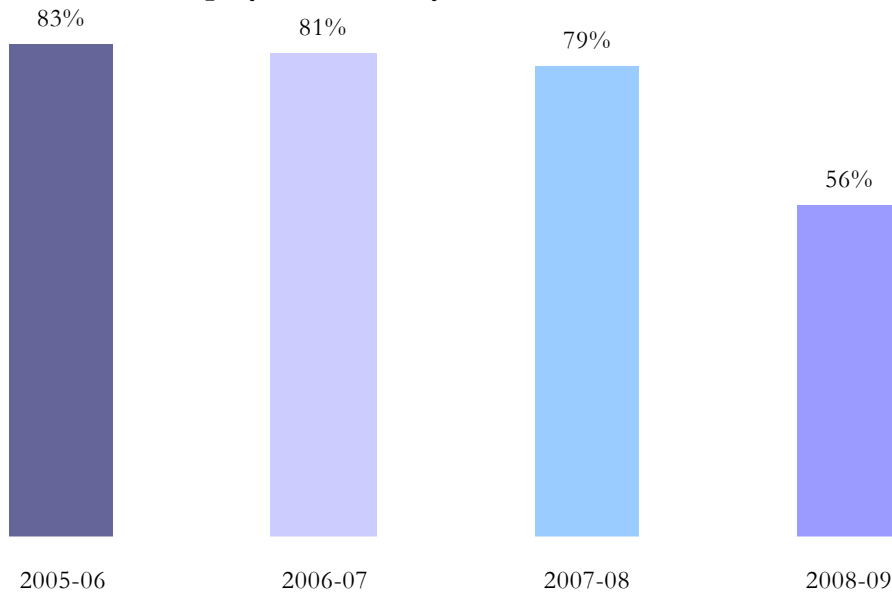

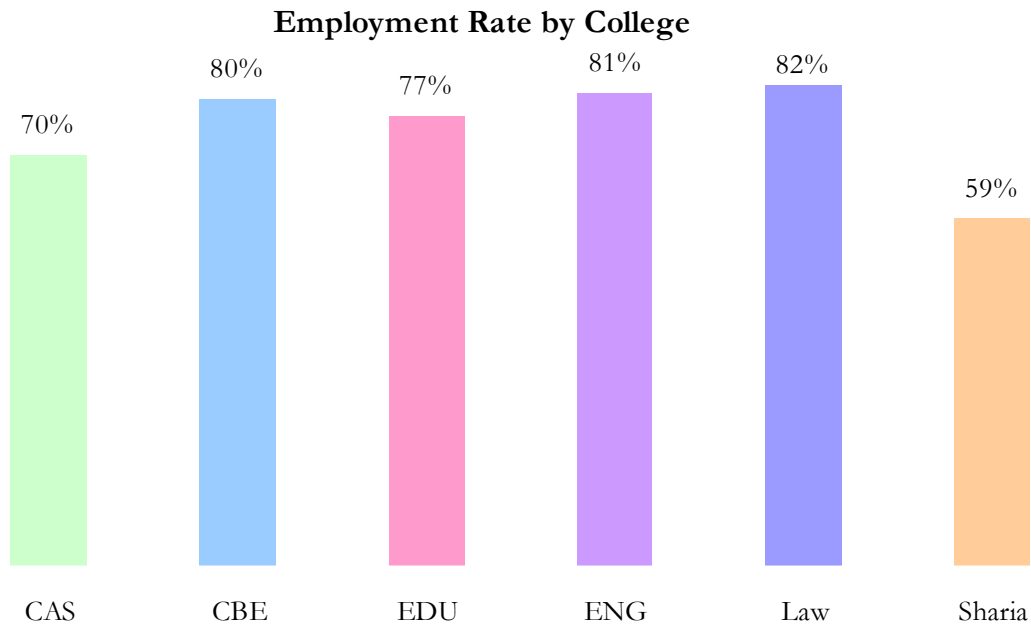


Employment Rate by Demography

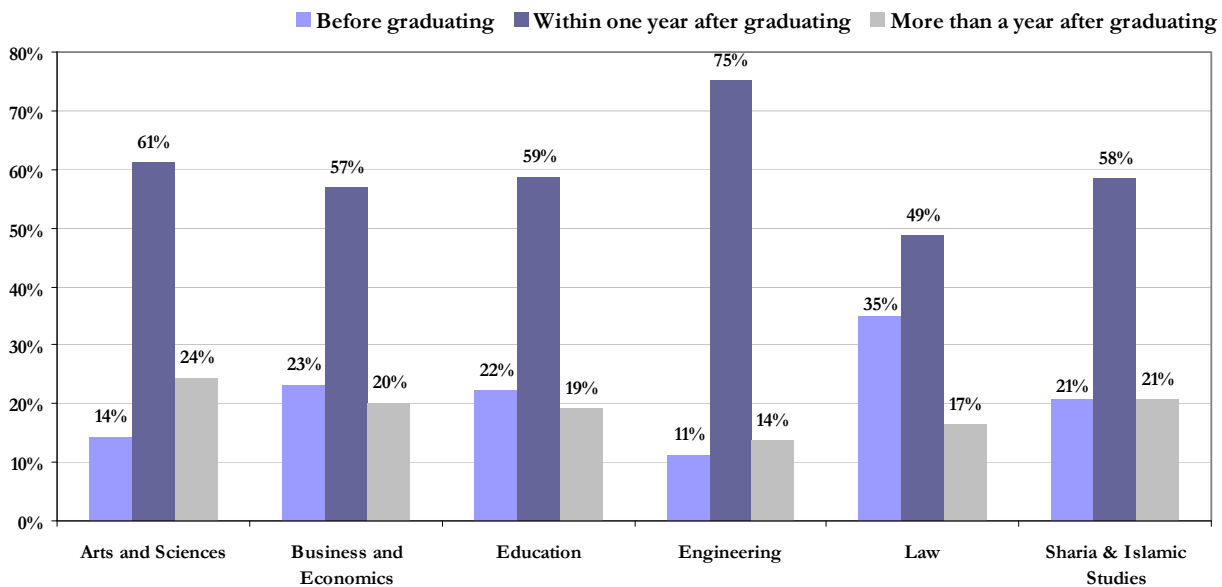

When did you start your current work?

In response to this question, 61% of QU alumni stated that they started working within one year after graduation and 18% of them started working before graduation. Only 21% stated more than a year after graduation. Among female graduates, 66% started working within a year compared to 53% of their male counterpart. If we compare Qatari and Non-Qatari nationalities, the difference is very minimal. (62% Qatari Vs. 60% Non-Qataris). By colleges, 75% from College of Engineering, 61% from College of Arts and Sciences, 57% from College of Business and Economics, 59% from College of Education, 44% from College of Law and 58% from College of Sharia started working within a year after graduation.

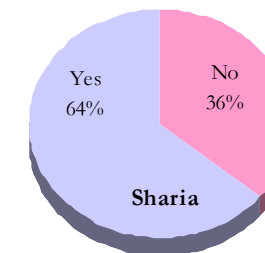
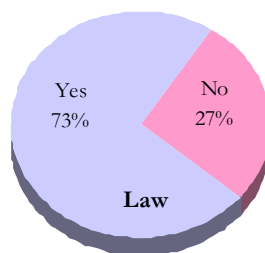
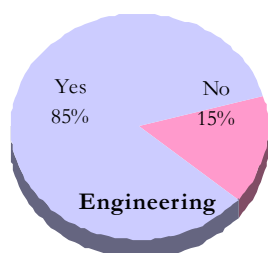
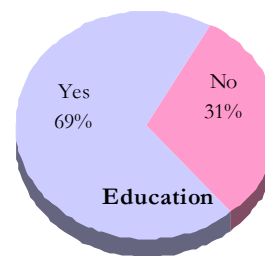
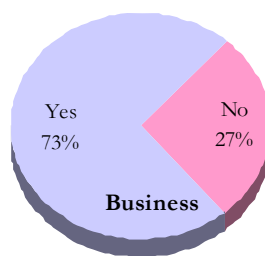
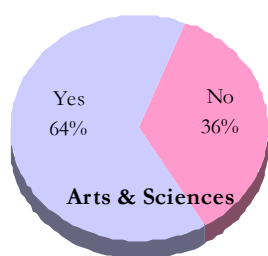


Did your QU education help you obtain your current job?

In response to the question, 70% said, yes. If we distribute the response by gender, 69% male and 71% female responded positively. Seventy percent Qataris compared to 72% Non-Qataris stated that QU education helped them to obtain their current job. By college, 85% of the College of Engineering alumni responded positively. The response rates for other colleges are: Arts & Sciences 64%, Business & Economics 73%, Education 69%, Law 73%, Sharia & Islamic Studies 64% felt the same way.

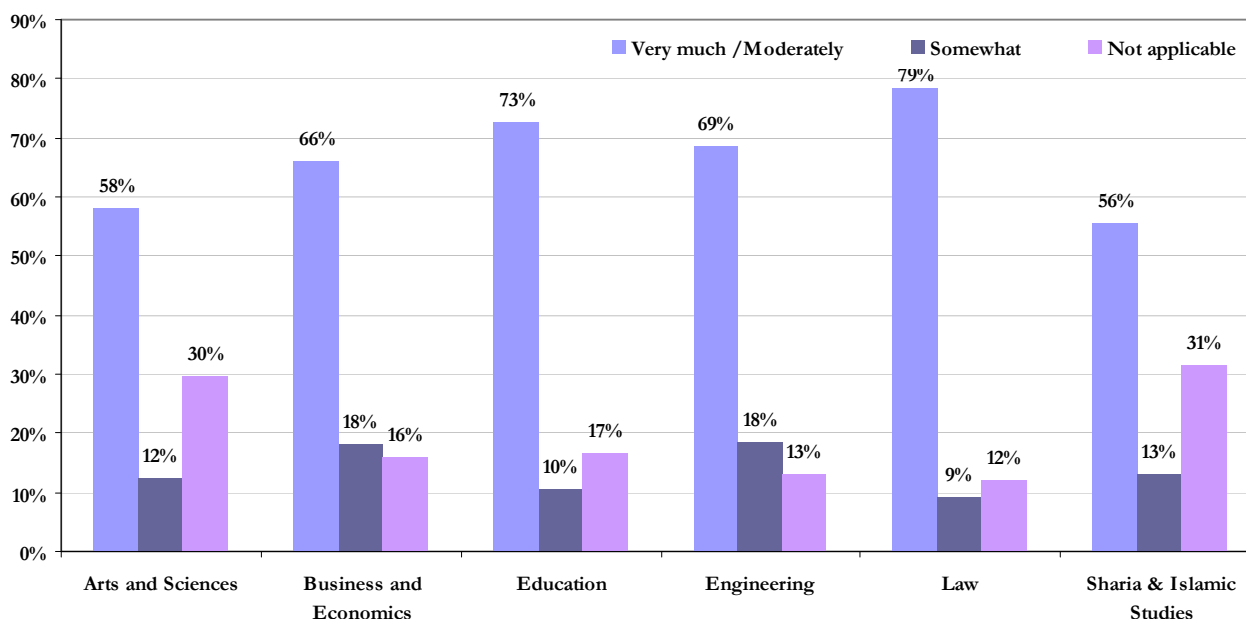


To what extent is your current work related to your area of study?

In response to the question, 64% replied with very much/moderately while 14% responded with somewhat. Only 22% stated, not applicable. If we distribute the response by gender, 66% male and 63% female replied with very much/moderately. There is not much difference between nationalities (65% Qataris Vs. 62% Non-Qataris). Responses with very much/moderately by college are as follows: College of Arts & Sciences 58%, College of Business & Economics 66%, College of Education 73%, College of Engineering 69%, College of Law 79%, and College of Sharia 56%.

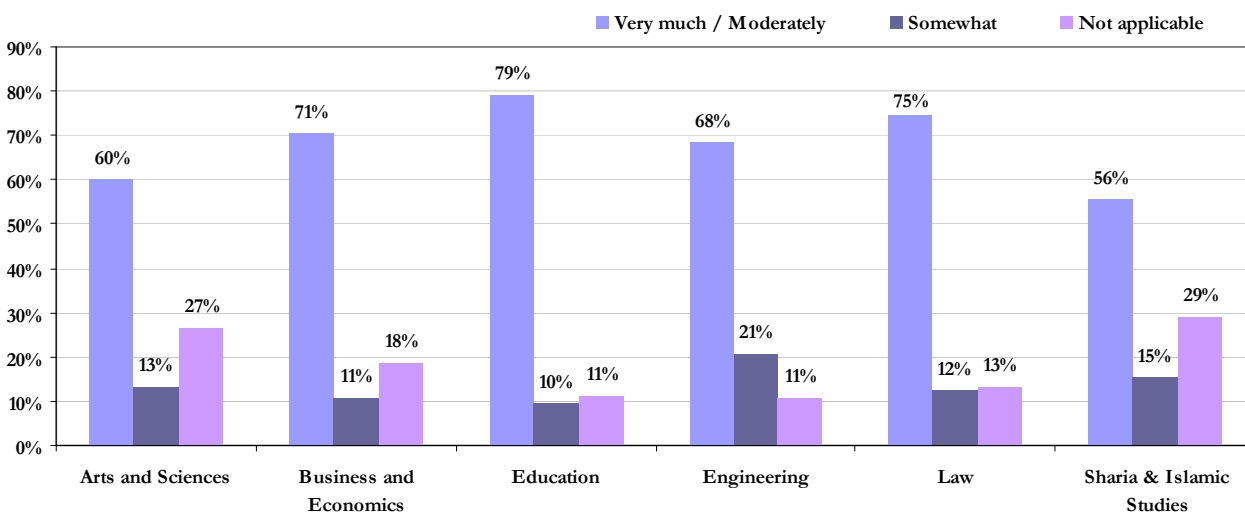


To what extent has your QU degree program help you perform in the workplace?

In response to the question, 67% replied with very much/moderately while 14% responded with somewhat. Only 20% stated, not applicable. If we distribute the response by gender, 69% male and 65% female replied with very much/moderately. A very minimal difference was observed between Qataris and Non-Qataris (66% vs. 67%) who replied with very much/moderately. Responses with very much/moderately by college are as follows: College of Arts & Sciences 60%, College of Business & Economics 71%, College of Education 79%, College of Engineering 68%, College of Law 75%, and College of Sharia 56%.

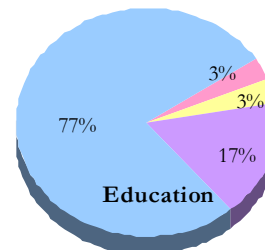
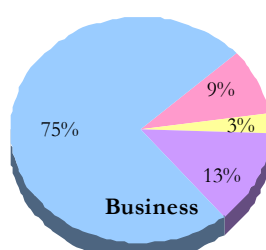
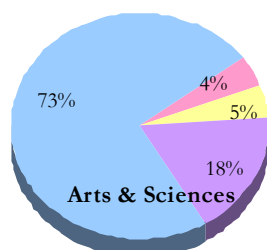
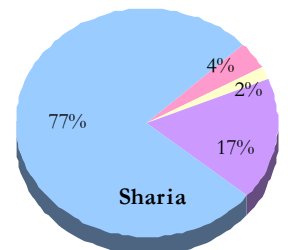
How would you compare yourself to your workmates who were graduated from other higher institutions?

In response to the question, 78% replied with well/moderately prepared while 6% with somewhat prepared, 3% poorly prepared and 16% said not applicable. If we distribute the response by gender, 76% male and 75% female replied with well/moderately prepared. Eighty percent of Non-Qataris compared to 74% Qataris thought that they were well/moderately prepared. By colleges, as high as 80% from Engineering and as low as 73% of Arts and Sciences graduates felt that they were well/moderately prepared.

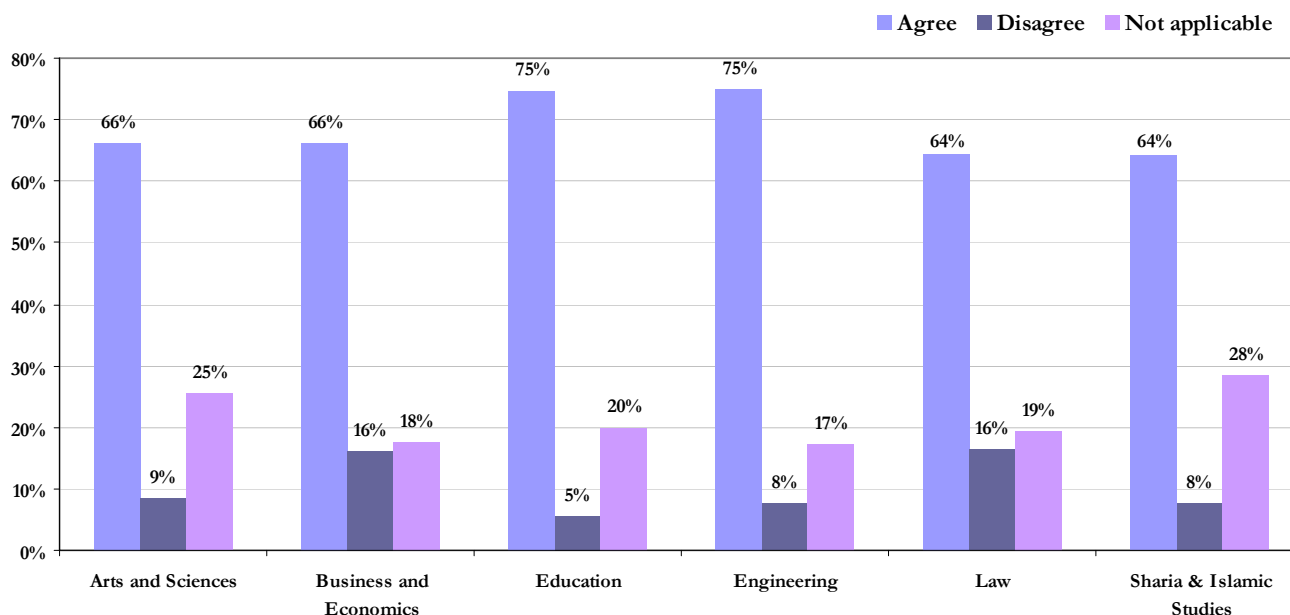


Does your employer have a positive perception of QU quality and standards?

In response to the question, 68% felt that their employers had positive perception while 22% responded with not applicable and only 10% disagreed. If we distribute the response by gender, 70% males compared to 67% females stated that their employers had positive perception. The positive response rates from Qatari and Non-Qatari nationals are around 68%. From the colleges, 75% from College of Engineering and College of Education, 66% from College of Arts & Sciences and Business & Economics, 64% from College of Law & College of Sharia felt the same way.

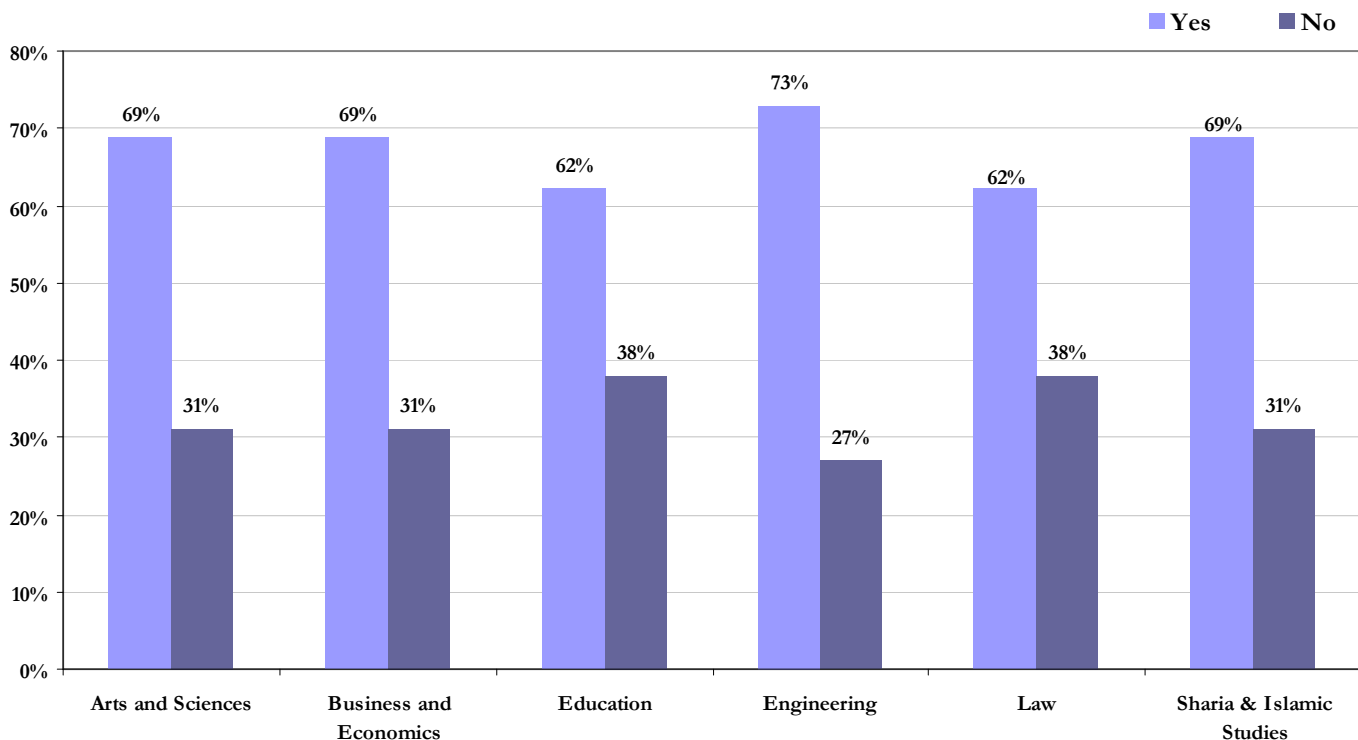


Has Qatar University kept in contact with you?

In response to the question, 68% responded positively. If we distribute the response by gender, 71% male and 67% female responded positively. The positive response rates for Qataris are 70% compared to 63% of Non-Qataris. More than 70% from 2005 to 2007 alumni compared to 49% from 2008 stated that QU kept in touch with them. By colleges, the contact rates are as high as 73% for the College of Engineering and as low as 62% from the College of Education & Law.
